Board of Supervisors

Meeting Minutes, December 10, 2012

- CALL TO ORDER** The West Pike Run Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, December 10, 2012. The meeting was called to order at 6 p.m. by Chairman Richard Molish.
- PLEADGE & ROLL CALL** Present at the meeting were Supervisor Rick Molish, Supervisor Phil Podroskey, Supervisor Laura Hough, Manager Erin Sakalik and Solicitor, Herman Bigi.
- PUBLIC DISCUSSION** Andrea Mock, Oak Road, informed that the Berry Lane sign is missing. John Farkas, Hickory Road, complained that the gas company is blocking the road.
- APPROVAL OF MINUTES** The Chairman asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the November 12, 2012, township meeting. Hough motioned, Podroskey seconded the motion. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.
- CORRESPONDENCE** Motion was made by Phil, seconded by Laura to approve the correspondence for the month of November. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.
- REPORTS** All reports submitted were approved by the Board. The reports included Police, Code Enforcement, Animal Control, and Financial. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.
- BILLS & PAYROLL** Motion was made by Phil, seconded by Laura to approve the payments of the bills and payroll for the month of November. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.
- OLD BUSINESS** **Whitehall Waterline Project.** Rick announced that on Thursday, Range Resources will be presenting a check in the amount of \$30,000 towards the Whitehall Waterline Project. He gave a quick update on the status.
- NEW BUSINESS** **Conditional Use for PA Reclamation.** Rick turned the floor over to Jamie Harshman, engineer, HMT & Associates. There was much confusion about the process of granting the conditional use for PA Reclamation (mineral extraction). The topic was tabled until a future meeting.
- Lien on 62 Hemlock Lane.** Motion was made by Laura, seconded by Phil to authorize the Solicitor to place a lien on 62 Hemlock Lane for the condemnation and demolition of a trailer located at that property. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.
- Advertisement of Ordinance.** The Board next authorized Mr. Bigi to advertise the PSAB Pension Joinder Agreement Ordinance for adoption at January's meeting. Podroskey motioned, Hough seconded the motion. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.
- Attendance for Rick at Roads Scholar Program.** Rick explained the program, which is for road masters. Motion was made by Phil, seconded by Laura to authorize Rick to participate in the Roads Scholar Program. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.
- Adoption of 2013 Budget.** The Chairman gave a brief description of the proposed budget. Phil motioned to adopt the 2013 township budget. Laura seconded the motion. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.

Roach Subdivision. Motion was made by Phil, seconded by Rick to approve the Roach subdivision. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.

Northwest Bank. Motion was made by Laura, seconded by Rick to add Northwest Savings Bank as depository for the township funds. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.

OTHER BUSINESS **Service Weapon.** Rick next asked for a motion to sign over the service weapon to Phil Podroskey, who served as chief of police of WPRT. Rick motioned, motion was seconded by Laura. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.

Donation. Laura made a motion to donate \$200 to the Daisytown Community Center for their Christmas party. The motion was seconded by Rick. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.

Recognition of TJ Dellirocili. The Chairman gave recognition to Eagle Scout TJ Dellirocili for his project located at Richeyville Road and Deems Park Road. He congratulated him for his outstanding effort in beautifying the township.

Township Survey. Rick announced the results from the township survey that had been circulating since June. There had been 77 responses. The top three concerns of those who had responded were: 1. Roads, 2. Water & Sewage, 3. Police Protection.
