Board of Supervisors Meeting Minutes, May 13, 2013

<u>Bids for Paving Cherry Street.</u> Motion carried to award the bid for paving Cherry Street to Victor Paving in the amount of \$50,342. The bids were opened at the special meeting on April 29, 2013, and tabled until further review. RCV: Hough – Yes, Podroskey – Yes, Molish – Yes.
