

ORDINANCE NO. 1 of 2012

WEST PIKE RUN TOWNSHIP
WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF WEST PIKE RUN TOWNSHIP, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 4902 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MOTOR VEHICLE CODE, SETTING FORTH A WEIGHT LIMITATION ON MCGIRTS ROAD OF A MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT OF 8 TONS AND ON DEEMS PARK ROAD OF A MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT OF 10 TONS.

WHEREAS, West Pike Run Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania, desires to enact this Ordinance by authority granted by Section 4902 (a) of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, making it unlawful for any person or persons to drive any vehicle or combination having a gross weight in excess of the maximum prescribed in this Ordinance.

Street: McGirts Road between T407 at the intersection of Deems Park Road and California Drive to SR 2041 which is the Beallsville Road, the ending, maximum gross weight of 8 tons.

Street: Deems Park Road starting at SR 2034 to California Drive (2038) and from California Drive to Bentleyville Borough Line, 10 tons.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be prosecuted under Section 4902 (a) and 4902 (g-1) of the Vehicle Code, and upon conviction, shall be guilty of a Summary Offense and shall be sentenced to pay a fine of \$75.00, except that any person convicted of operating a vehicle with a gross weight in excess of a posted weight shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$150.00 plus \$150.00 for each 500 pounds, or part thereof, in excess of 3000 pounds over the maximum allowable weight.
