- 1. The proposed ordinance be advertised in the official newspaper of West Pike Run Township and such advertisement provide notice that the proposed ordinance is available during regular office hours of the Township at the Township Municipal Building, 238 Pike Run Drive, Daisytown, Pennsylvania 15427.
- 2. That pursuant to the requirements of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Code (MPC) that the proposed ordinance be sent to the Washington County Planning Commission and the Township Planning Commission in order to allow them to offer written comments on the zoning amendment.
- 3. That pursuant to procedural requirements imposed by the MPC, a public hearing be scheduled, duly advertised and held after the expiration of the forty-five (45) day review period for Washington County Planning Commission to review the zoning amendment.
